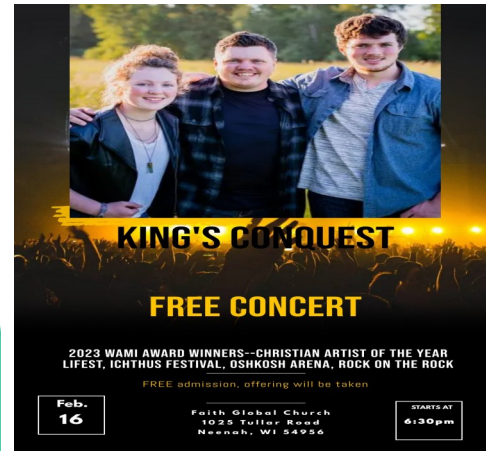
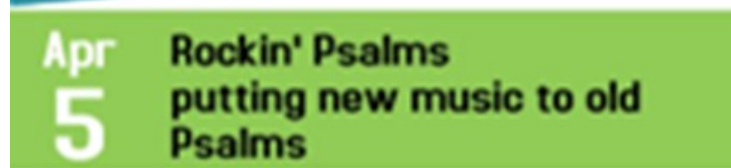
On February 16, 2024: 6:30 P.M.

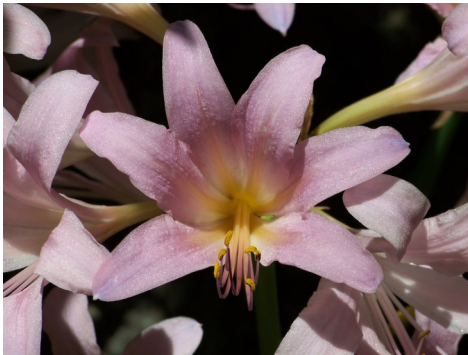
