Jim Hoyman who is a veteran and serves as part of the Military Funeral Honors Program in the Valley.

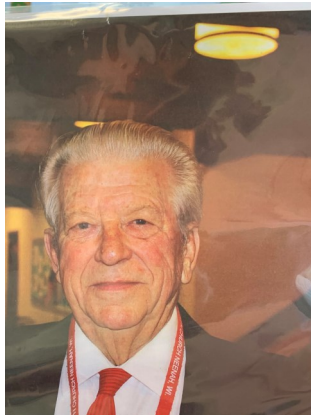
Neale Caflisch served during World War II in the Army Air Corp.
