Linda Fritz – Continued healing form hip surgery

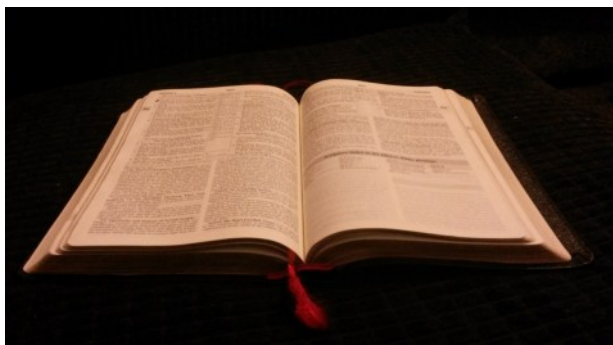
Keith Irish – went on a Badger Honor Flight to Washington DC this past week

**"A steward of tradition":** They educate the next generation, teaching bible stories and imparting godly wisdom.

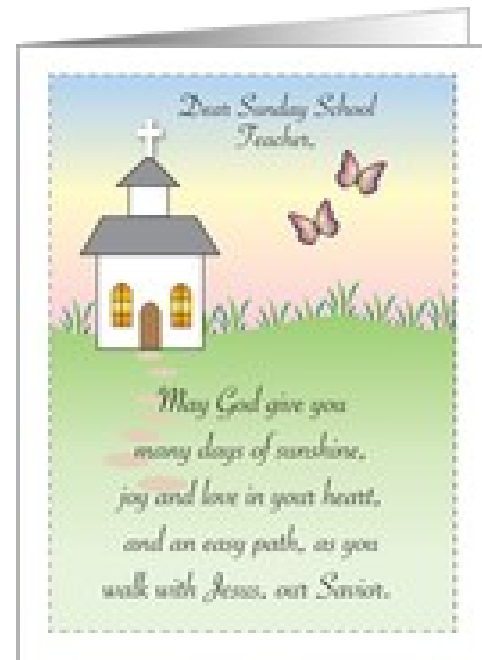
**"A lamp to light the way":** They are often likened to a candle, consuming their own time and energy to light the way for others.

**THE FAMILY RADIO NETWORK'S 34TH ANNUAL  
HELP FOR THE HOMELESS HYGIENE DRIVE**

APPLETON, Wis., May 7, 2026 - The Family Radio Network's 34th annual Help for the Homeless Hygiene Drive collected more than \$742,775 in hygiene and cleaning supplies, benefiting 139 crisis programs in 22 Wisconsin communities.

More than 1,171 businesses, churches and schools hosted collection boxes for the drive, gathering personal care and cleaning items for local agencies serving individuals and families in need.

The Family partners with local crisis programs and homeless coalitions, inviting community members to donate essential items. The donations help agencies direct limited financial resources toward staffing, housing, nutritious food, education and counseling for those they serve.

Since 1992, the Help for the Homeless Drive has provided \$7.4 million in supplies to Wisconsin crisis programs, with donations staying in the communities where they are collected. Thank you all donated to this event.....
