

From the desk of Pastor Tim Albrecht Faith Global Methodist church

February 2024

Dear Faith Church,

We have begun the year 2024 with a whole lot of unexpected things. For instance, who would have thought the Packers would have been in the playoffs? Or, that this winter would be very mild? Yes, we did have a big snowstorm in January and a week of extreme cold. However, as of this writing everything is above freezing again.

Now, as February begins Valentine's Day and Ash Wednesday both happen on the same day. Maybe the coincidence of this is about love. On Valentine's Day we are intentional about telling those who we are close to that we love them, and express it by sending cards, and/or maybe even sharing some candy. Ash Wednesday, we are reminded of our sinful nature and state of mind. However, we have a God who loves us very very much. And He expresses that love for us by giving us a Savior in Jesus Christ. Because none of us are good enough or could do enough good things to satisfy God. This love is far greater than anything that we can do on Valentine's Day. Ash Wednesday also begins the season of Lent. Lent, that period of 40 days of preparation to celebrate the resurrection of Jesus Christ on Easter. Why 40 days? It represents the days in the wilderness that Jesus spent when he was tempted by Satan. After that time in the wilderness, was also the start of Jesus' public ministry which we read about in the gospels.

For Faith Church, the season of Lent we will begin a new sermon series starting on February 11th entitled, Seeing God as a Perfect Father and seeing you as loved, pursued and secure, by Louie Giglio. How you view God informs everything about who you are and who you are becoming. Seeing God as a Perfect Father invites you to: see that God is the perfection of your earthly father, not a reflection of him; discover how to walk in the freedom of your identity as a loved child, uniquely created by God; and break the chains of generational patterns by forgiving your imperfect family. There will be a Lenten study that will coincide with the series as we have done in the past. There will be more information coming regarding the study and the time it will be presented.

Also, our Ash Wednesday service will be on Wednesday February 14 at 6:00 p.m. with being marked by Ashes and Holy Communion.

Scripture

Then Jesus came to them and said, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age." Matthew 28:18-20 (NIV)

Have you ever read a story or seen a movie about someone putting a message inside of a bottle and putting it in the ocean? Perhaps it was someone who has been stranded on an island in the middle of the ocean and put a message in a bottle hoping that someone would find it and come to rescue him. Maybe it was someone who just wanted to see where the wind and the waves might take the message. I read a true story about a man named Harold Meyers who went on a cruise in the Caribbean. While on the ship, he took three bottles and placed a message with his name and address and a dollar inside each bottle. The dollar was to pay the postage so that the person who found the message would write to him and tell him where they found it. Next, he put a cork in the bottles, sealed them with wax, and threw them over the side of the ship into the ocean. His friends all teased him saying that he was just throwing good money into the ocean, two were found and he received a reply from the person who found it. Two out of three! That's amazing!

To tell you the truth," Mr. Meyers said, "I was shocked. I guess I really never expected to hear from anybody at all." I was thinking, perhaps that might be a good way to spread the message of Jesus all around the world. We could write John 3:16 on pieces of paper. You know John 3:16, don't you? "For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life." We could write that on a piece of paper, put it in a bottle, and drop it in the ocean. Then the good news of Jesus would float all around the world.

Does that sound like a good plan to you? Well, to tell the truth, I think that sounds like a pretty foolish plan. I don't think that would get the message of God's love to very many people. What would be a good way to get the good news of God's love to people all around the world? Jesus told his disciples how he wanted it done, and the plan is still just as good today as it was then.

Jesus said, "Go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you." Jesus wants us to tell everyone we meet about his love for them and share with them what he has taught us in the Bible. He didn't say, "Send a message in a bottle," he said, "Go and make disciples."

Dear Father, help us to obey the command that you gave us to go and make disciples. In Jesus' name we pray. Amen.


