When March comes to a close, we begin Holy Week and prepare to celebrate Easter and the empty tomb. There will be more information coming out regarding Holy Week events later in the month.

By the way, March madness, in the secular world there will be a basketball tournament and the opening day of the baseball season happens too. However, in the midst of all these things we in gratitude of God's blessings, provisions, and his Son Jesus Christ.

Regarding Disaffiliation:

Now that Faith Church has voted to disaffiliate. The Ad Council met on February 28th to begin working on the next steps. Those steps include the new name for Faith Church, moving to the Global Methodist Church, and legal representation for Faith Church. These issues need to be addressed. Because they impact incorporation, the deed, tax identification and financing to pay the exit fee. Also, the time frame to accomplish this and meet deadlines is of importance too.

The Ad Council has approved the following:

- -name: Faith Global Methodist Church
- -joining the Global Methodist Church
- -hiring the National Center for Life and Liberty to handle legal issues. The NCLL is a non-profit legal ministry that works with churches. It is working with other United Methodist Churches in Wisconsin and across the country who are also disaffiliating. Their cost is \$1000.00 per year for their services. That would cover all the legal Issues that Faith Church would incur during this process.

The name Faith Global Methodist Church was chosen for a couple of reasons. We can still be known as Faith Church and Methodist would still be in our title. Global would say that we are part of the new Global Methodist Denomination and no longer United Methodist. Also, we need to let the Wisconsin Annual Conference know what our new name will be before March 31st.

The advantages to being part of the Global Methodist Church first and foremost center around the authority of scripture followed by the trust clause. In the Global Methodist Church, Faith Church will own its own building and property. Also, the Global Church will be involved in pastoral appointments and the church will have more input in this process than it has in the past.

What is needed from you, the congregation, is for you to vote to approve the new name and joining the Global Methodist Church. A ballot will be in next Sunday's bulletin, March 12th and it can be put in the offering. The Ad Council is asking that you vote yes and a simple majority (51%) is needed.

If you have any questions regarding the name feel free to speak with anyone on the Ad Council.

"But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God." John 1:12 and "The Spirit itself beareth witness with our spirit, that we are the children of God."

Have you ever gone to a family gathering and you were known as so-and-so's daughter or son? Maybe they even introduced that way. This is Aunt Sally's grandchild, people might say. Wouldn't you love to be known as one of God's children? When they see you, wouldn't it be great if because of what you say and how you act that you are clearly one of God's children? A lot of times if someone doesn't know you, they think they know you by who you hang around with or who you are related to. God wants us to listen to him and to behave in such a way that there can be no doubt that you are God's child, in addition to being Velma's son, Tom's niece, or Susie's cousin. Some people may think that because grandma or grandpa, mom or dad, or sisters or brothers have developed a connection with God, that they will in some way get into Heaven on their shirt tails. After all, that's the way it is with royalty, people might think. When a man becomes a president or a king, his wife and children automatically become royalty. This is not the situation in the Kingdom of God. God has no grandchildren – only children.

We are all individually accountable to God. When he saves us by His awesome power, we are adopted as His personal sons and daughters. Not one of us can claim the faith of our father or mother as our own. There is no such thing as a "spiritual grandchild" of God. We each must come to Him on our own. If we don't have our own faith, we have no faith at all. Even though it is the same faith as others (because it is faith in Jesus), it is not our faith, until we own it in our hearts and minds. That was true for our parents; it's true for our children, and it is true for each of us. God gave the privilege of becoming His children—His sons and daughters. How? By receiving Jesus Christ by faith, by letting go of the coattails of parents and grandparents and praying to God. When you do that, God becomes your "Daddy," and you enter into the most intimate and loving privilege in all of the world.

On February 12th. There are also drop off locations at Festival Foods or Walgreens Stores. The Family's annual Help for the Homeless hygiene drive works with area homeless coalitions every spring to stock the shelves of 90+ homeless and crisis programs in 19 Wisconsin communities in our listening areas.

The goal of Help for the Homeless is to supply a year's worth of products to each agency.

In 2022, generous community members at 900+ businesses, churches, and schools hosted collection boxes and donated \$530,000 worth of laundry soap, shampoo, toothpaste, deodorant, etc. to their local crisis programs.

The drive has provided \$4.8 million dollars worth of hygiene supplies to local crisis programs and those they serve over the past 31 years.

Donations of supplies and financial support will be used in the community where they come from.
