Theme

Taking up the cross to follow Jesus (Mark 8:27 – 38)

Object

a duck decoy and duck whistle, or a picture of these items from a sportsman's catalog

Scripture

Jesus and his disciples went on to the villages around Caesarea Philippi. On the way he asked them, "Who do people say I am?" They replied, "Some say John the Baptist; others say Elijah; and still others, one of the prophets." "But what about you?" he asked. "Who do you say I am?" Peter answered, "You are the Christ." Mark 8:27-29 (NIV)

Children – have you ever seen ducklings following their parents? Why do they follow them? (listen to the answers and help the children know that ducklings are safe when they follow their parents – just like with human beings.) But sometimes ducklings are distracted by duck decoys or duck whistles. Help the children understand that hunters use these items to draw the ducks away from their flock. Just as ducks can be drawn away and are no longer safe, we can follow wrong paths and get ourselves into trouble, and go far away from Jesus and His teachings.

Explain to the children that although some people may tell you that many ways lead to heaven and to Jesus, that Jesus taught us in the Bible that there is only one way to follow him. Although it isn't always the easy way or the fun way, it is the right way. If we choose to follow Jesus, the rewards are always going to be worth it.

Have the children answer the questions, "What can you do to follow Jesus better? Can you do this? Will you do it?"

Dear Jesus, help us to follow you more closely. Give us the courage to do the right thing, even when it isn't easy. Amen.



Jeff & Wonita are involved in planting tribal churches as support missionaries of Ethnos360 (formerly known as New Tribes Mission). They work in Arizona, USA, at the home office of Ethnos360 Aviation.

Jeff is from Pennsylvania and has been interested in aviation since childhood. He attended a Christian

aviation camp as a teenager where he became aware of many missionary aviation needs and opportunities. He completed Bible training and missionary aviation training (pilot and aircraft mechanic certification) at a small school in Michigan. Uncertain of which mission to join he served as a volunteer aircraft mechanic in Colombia, South America, with Ethnos360 in 1991. He then decided to join Ethnos360 fulltime, completing missionary and aviation training in 1996. He was enroute to Senegal, Africa, but before he left, he became reacquainted with Wonita, whom he had met in Colombia.

Since 1997 Wonita has been his wife and best friend. Jeff holds a Commercial Pilot certificate with multi-engine and instrument ratings and is a licensed aircraft mechanic. After a serious illness in 1998 Jeff rerouted his energies away

from flying and into diverse ministries over the years: coaching young people through the lengthy missionary aviation training process, traveling as a representative of Ethnos360 Aviation to training schools and air shows, desktop publishing, and other US-based projects. Wonita is also from Pennsylvania. She wanted to be a missionary among remote unreached peoples but became a teacher to pay off her college debt. After becoming aware of the need for teachers to care for missionaries' children, and equipped with a Master's degree in elementary education and several years' experience, she joined Ethnos360 in 1988. In Colombia, South America, Wonita taught various subjects to missionary kids (MKs) from 1989-1996. Aware of the struggle some MKs experienced due to learning difficulties she also became a Certified Educational Therapist to work one-on-one with students outside of the classroom. Wonita also served for three years as the co-administrator of the Ethnos360 school before it was closed due to insurgent activity.

In Arizona she continued working with students having learning issues. Today Wonita is the Media Manager for Ethnos360 Aviation, writing newsletters and articles while helping the media team expand Web and print endeavors.
