SUMMER CHALLENGE IS HERE!

I have been thinking about what a 2026 summer challenge might look like for the Christian believer in the Fox Cities Area. Whatever you decide, see if someone will do it with you. Make sure you tell at least 1-3 people the challenge you are undertaking. Here are four different challenges to choose from:

1. During the summer there are times when Christians go on vacation to get away from the normal routine of life. Sometimes they also go on vacation from Sunday morning worship, Oh no! Oh yes! So for the number one and **easiest challenge... make sure you attend church on each summer Sunday morning.** Two thoughts:
 - a. Now with technology, you can always attend church online. The Neenah church has it live each Sunday morning beginning at 8:45am (it could be watched a little later in the morning at 10:30am too, or at your convenience.) But even when you are away... no excuses... online or in person attend church on a Sunday morning!
 - b. Now, it is always best to go in person, and if out of town an option might be to go to a local church and experience church with some new friends.

2. During the summer people may take an easy approach to reading the bible. So, to make it simple, **this summer read through the four gospels (Matthew, Mark, Luke, John) of Jesus Christ.**
 - a. Now when you read the gospels:
 - i. **First begin with Mark** as it gets right to the point.
 - ii. **Secondly, read John** as it comes at Jesus from a more spiritual perspective.
 - iii. **Third, read Matthew** as it addresses Jesus as the fulfillment of the Old Testament's Messiah.
 - iv. Now, I might say here, **read John again** as it simply does not follow the same stories as the other three gospels and you don't want to forget Jesus' "I AM" statements which are only made in John)
 - v. **Finally, read Luke**, who comes at the gospel of Jesus with the eye of the historian who interviews people for their experiences.
 - b. It is best if you spread it out over the course of the summer. **Read about 1.5 - 2 chapters a day** (or do two a day and take Sundays off because you'll be focusing on church!)

3. **Memorize some scripture**, as Psalm 119:11 states, “I have hidden your word in my heart that I might not sin against you.” But you can also memorize so that you can continue to walk on the path of righteousness, or on the straight and narrow path.
 - a. You could memorize 5 key assurance verses:
 - i. Assurance of Salvation - 1 John 5:11-12;
 - ii. Assurance of Answered Prayer - John 16:24;
 - iii. Assurance of Victory - 1 Corinthians 10:13;
 - iv. Assurance of Forgiveness - 1 John 1:9;
 - v. Assurance of Guidance - Proverbs 3:5-6
 - b. Memorize 1 Corinthians 13... the love chapter and as many chapters as you want.
 - c. Memorize some Psalms - 1, 23, 51 or as many as you want.

4. **Read a single chapter of the bible five times each week and think quietly on it for 10-15 minutes.** Questions you can ponder...
 - a. What it is God is saying to me?
 - b. What do I learn about God?
 - c. What do I learn about the people’s response to God?
 - d. What is God asking me to do?
 - e. Other questions?

Whatever you choose above, or one you decide to do yourself, enjoy spending time with God and make sure you share what you are learning with a friend!

Children's Message

Theme:

The Holy Trinity

Object:

Ingredients to make a s'more. (Graham cracker, marshmallow, chocolate)

How many of you have heard the word, "Trinity?" Do any of you know what that word means? Trinity means three-in-one. We have called the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit, a "Holy Trinity." Have you heard that the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit are One? It's hard for us to understand how three different beings are still the same God.

I am thinking of ingredients that your mom maybe has in the kitchen. These ingredients may help you understand this. Do any of you know what a Smore is? A smore is a wonderful treat made of three different things. This graham cracker is one part of a s'more. Just like the "Father" is one part of what we call the "Holy Trinity." It says in 2 Corinthians 6:18, "I will be a Father to you, and you will be my sons and daughters, says the Lord Almighty." This verse is really clear that God is our Father.

Another part of a smore is this chocolate. "The Son," is another part of what we call "The Holy Trinity." Who is the Son? That's right...Jesus. Now, how can Jesus also be God at the same time? It says in John 1:1, "In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word WAS God." Then in verse 14, it says, "The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us." So, if the Word was God, and the Word became flesh and lived on earth with us, we know that it was Jesus. It also says in Colossians 1:15, "He is the image of the invisible God." And again the Bible says in John 10:30, "I and the Father are One." Jesus is God in a human form.

The third part of a smore, is a toasted marshmallow. The last part of the "Holy Trinity" is the Holy Spirit God sent the Holy Spirit to us after Jesus went back to Heaven, so we could keep Jesus with us. The Holy Spirit is the very presence of God within all believers. The Holy Spirit is our teacher and guide. He teaches us truth, and guides us when we stray away from God. It says in 1 John 5:7, "For there are three that bear record in heaven, the Father, the Word, and the Holy Ghost: and these three are One." When we put these three things together, [show the s'more ingredients] we get a trinity of wonderful flavors to satisfy our taste buds. When we put all of these things together, [show the Trinity], we get the most satisfying treat of all. We get the "Holy Trinity," and that will satisfy ALL your needs and desires.

Dear Lord, thank you for being everything we could ever need or want. Thank you for being all things, even when we don't understand everything. Amen.

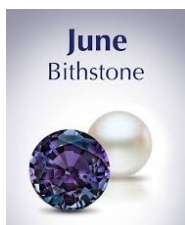
